Variance Appeal

- Fall 2012: Permits sought for home addition, greenhouse, rec room and guesthouse reusing existing barns within the setback protecting Bridger Creek
- Construction proceeds without permits; BCPOA files complaint; county considers after-the-fact permit applications
- Jan. 2013: CUPs for rec room and guesthouse approved; variances denied due to floodplain concerns
- April 2013: county permits variances to be withdrawn and resubmitted, based on "new information"
- May 2013: General Meeting membership approves appeal
- 2014
 - After much wrangling over the record, briefs filed
 - County inspects project and declares it complete, but refuses to disclose this fact, opposing BCPOA discovery requests
- 2015-2016 case in limbo; assigned to a new judge (McElyea, replacing Salvagni)
- 2017
 - County & applicants move to dismiss, claiming project completion renders BCPOA's claims moot
 - BCPOA settles with applicants
- 2018
 - BCPOA settles with County
 - Settlement implemented in zoning

BCPOA-County Settlement Terms

Objective: fix troublesome procedural practices that might recur in future projects

- Clarify the date of record for decisions
- Hear variance applications before CUPs that require them
- Clarify what changes require a Land Use Permit
- Clarify the criteria for variances
- Prevent bogus re-applications within 1 year of a denial
- Provide notice of the right to appeal on permits, noting that applicants proceed against a pending appeal at their own risk

14.2 Repeal

Genesis: dispute over a small tract that was divided in the 60s, and subsequently treated as a single parcel



Impact

A few small parcels that were formerly aggregated are now separately developable






Zoning Updates

- Provide a rationale for changes


Budworm Spraying Protocol
